For-hire vessel guides are subject to the Interim Guidance for Commercial Fishing Services and For-Hire Vessels During the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency, available separately at forward.ny.gov. iii) Other outdoor, low-risk recreational activities under this code may be permitted only if and as described on Empire State Development's "Guidance for Determining Whether a Business Enterprise is Subject to a Workforce Reduction under Recent Executive Orders," available at: <https://esd.ny.gov/guidance-executive-order-2026>.
